1. Please answer the question "Why do you want to work in a veterinary hospital?" in 100 words or less.
2. Please explain in 100 words or less what experience you have that would help you work in the fast-paced, emotionally charged positions offered by our hospital.
3. Please list 3 professional references that we may call. These need to be people that you worked with such as managers, owners, etc.
4. If you had to describe yourself in one word, what would it be?
5. Have you ever had a pet that needed emergency care? If yes, please give a description of the situation along with how you felt about the care that you and your pet received.
6. Because we are an emergency center, we treat pets that have been severely injured or are gravely ill. Describe how this might affect you.
7. We occasionally see pets that have been mistreated or abused. How would you handle this?
8. Are you a member of, or do you support any animal related organizations or clubs? If yes, which organizations, and how are you affiliated with them?
9. Because we are an emergency center, many of the pets that are presented to us for possible treatment die or are euthanized (put to sleep). Sometimes this may happen multiple times a day. How would this make you feel?
